2022-2023 Admissions Information

Application Window- When and how do I apply?

- **Application Window for the 2022-2023 academic year will be open Tuesday July 12th 10:00 am – July 13th 10:00 am**
- Once the Application Window closes on July 13th the program will no longer accept applications until July 2023.
- Applications will only be accepted through the online portal on the [BTC Nursing website](#).
- **All applicants must be Program-Ready prior to applying.** Students are Program-Ready once they have completed the following Nursing Program admission's requirements:
 - ✓ Current BTC application of file with Nursing as the program of intent.
 - ✓ Prerequisite foundational courses completed with required minimum grades and number of credits. **Transcript evaluation process for all courses taken at another institution must be complete prior to applying.**
 - ✓ Make *Proficiency* level or higher in all four areas of the ATI TEAS on one TEAS transcript and submit ATI Official Transcript only if taken at another school. *If ATI TEAS was taken at the BTC Assessment Center no Official ATI Transcript is required.*
 - ✓ **Approved** Healthcare Experience Verification form. Applicants must submit completed Healthcare Experience Verification Form and any accompanying documentation for Nursing Program review and approval.
- **Deadline to submit transcripts, Healthcare Experience Verification form, and ATI TEAS transcript is June 30th, 2022.** Any received after June 30th will not be processed for the 2022-2023 Application Window.

Next Steps- What happens after I submit my application?

- The Do-Not-Reply@btc.edu email that you receive after you click the submit button will be your notification that your application has been received. Please be aware that this email may end up in your email junk folder. The next correspondence from the program will be the email notification of complete or incomplete.
- If you need assistance during the first two hours of the Application Window a virtual lobby will be available. The link to the Application Window virtual lobby will be posted on the Nursing website the morning of the Application Window opening.
- **Applicants will be notified by email that their application is *complete* or *incomplete* on or before July 26th. Only complete applications will be placed on the APL-N waitlist.**
- The APL-N waitlist will be sorted by date/time and number of points with earliest date/time stamp and 5 points at the top of the list. Applicants will be offered seats based on their placement on the APL-N.
- All applicants not sorted into cohorts will be kept on an alternate list sorted by first-come-first-served and highest number of points. This list will be maintained only until the first day of Spring quarter 2023.

Notification of Applicants- When do I find out if I got in?

- **Offers of 2022-2023 cohort seats will be made by email on or before August 9th.** Applicants on the APL-N waitlist not offered a cohort seat will be notified of their status as an alternate by the same date.
- **At no time will applicants be notified of their place (number) on the APL-N. The email notification of "complete application" means you have been placed on the APL-N in order of your date/time stamp and number of points.**
- **A seat offer must be accepted by email by deadline provided in the seat offer email (generally 5 business days). No deferral of seat offer will be allowed.** If an applicant declines a seat in a cohort that seat will then be offered to the first applicant on the alternate list and not to an applicant who has already been awarded a seat in another cohort.
- Students offered seats in Winter and Spring cohorts will be required to reconfirm their acceptance at a later date.

This preview of the online application form is being provided to prepare applicants to accurately complete the form. Please note the actual online application will look different from this preview but the required fields will be the same. Applicants must enter their information accurately to be considered for admission to the Registered Nursing Program.

For a Registered Nursing Program application to be considered, the following courses must be completed, final grades posted, Healthcare Experience approved, and ATI TEAS scores on file with BTC.

Completion of the following courses with a minimum grade of 3.0 (B) or higher in each course:

- English Composition I (ENGL& 101) 5 credits
- Introduction of Statistics (MATH& 146) 5 credits
- Lifespan Psychology (PSYC& 200) 5 credits
- Human A & P 1 (BIOL& 241) 5 credits
- Human A & P 2 (BIOL& 242) 5 credits
- Introduction to Chemistry (CHEM& 121) OR General Chemistry w/ Lab I (CHEM& 161) 5 credits
- Microbiology (BIOL& 260) 5 credits

Completion of the following courses with a minimum grade of 2.0 (C) or higher in each course:

- General Biology with Lab (BIOL& 160) 5 credits
- General Psychology (PSYC& 100) 5 credits
- Humanities Electives 10 credits - may combine multiple courses
- Communication Electives 5 credits - may combine multiple courses (CMST& 210 not accepted)

Additional requirements for entry:

- Approved Healthcare Experience Verification form on file with BTC
- ATI TEAS: score at the "PROFICIENT" level or higher in each of the four areas on one transcript
