# Getting Started at BTC

# Apply for Admission to a Dental Hygiene Program Cohort

# Annual Program List-Dental Hygiene (APL-DH)

The Annual Program List-Dental Hygiene (APL-DH) is a blended process of first-come, first-served and ranking by points for qualified Dental Hygiene Program applicants that is valid for one academic year. The APL-DH will only accept applications during the **DH Application Window**, generally in May. Once all the seats have been awarded for the upcoming academic year, the APL-DH will be maintained as an alternate list until the start of fall quarter. On the first day of fall quarter, the waitlist will be cleared and applicants not selected for that academic year will need to reapply once the next academic year's APL-DH Application Window opens.

## How to Apply

- **1.** All applicants to the BTC Dental Hygiene Program must be **Program-Ready** before they can apply online during the Application Window. Students are Program-Ready once they have completed the following:
  - o Current BTC application on file with Dental Hygiene as the program of intent.
  - Complete all prerequisite foundational courses with required minimum grades and number of credits. Transcript
    evaluation process for all courses taken at another institution must be complete. \*
  - Score at the Proficient level or higher in all four areas of the ATI TEAS on one TEAS transcript. Official ATI
    Transcript required only if not taken at BTC Assessment Center. \*
  - Approved Dental Hygiene Healthcare Experience Verification form. Applicants must submit completed Dental
    Hygiene Healthcare Experience Verification Form and any accompanying documentation for program review and
    approval prior to applying to the program. \*
  - \* See <u>BTC Dental Hygiene Program website</u> for deadline to submit transcripts for evaluation, Dental Hygiene Healthcare Experience Verification form and ATI TEAS scores.
- 2. Apply online during the **Application Window**. See the Dental Hygiene website for dates and link to the application portal. The online application will ask you to answer the questions below. The answers to these questions, as verified by program staff, will be the basis of awarding points. **Incorrect answers will not be awarded points.** 
  - 1. I have successfully (required minimum grade) completed **15** or more credits of dental hygiene foundational prerequisite courses at BTC (repeated courses only count once). Yes No
  - 2. I have successfully (required minimum grade) completed **30** or more credits of dental hygiene foundational prerequisite courses at BTC (repeated courses only count once). Yes No
  - 3. I successfully completed an Allied Health program or certificate at BTC. Yes No
  - 4. I applied last academic year to the Dental Hygiene Program with a complete application. Yes No

Upon submitting the online form, applicants will receive an automatically generated no-reply email stating the application has been received. Applicants may only submit one online application per Application Window. At no time will applicants be notified of their place on the APL-DH.

## **Awarding Cohort Seats**

- Only Program-Ready students with complete applications will be placed on the APL-DH.
- The APL-DH will be sorted first-come-first-served and highest number of points with earliest date/time stamp and highest number of points at the top of the list.
- Applicants will be awarded program seats based on the applicant's placement on the APL-DH.
- Applicants not awarded cohorts seats will be kept on an alternate list until the first day of fall quarter. After the start
  of fall quarter, the APL-DH will be cleared and applicants not awarded seats will need to reapply during the next
  Application Window. Transcripts, Healthcare Experience form and TEAS scores do not need to be resubmitted.
- No deferral of seat offer will be allowed. Applicants may only accept or decline a seat. If an applicant declines a seat in a cohort, that seat will then be offered to the first applicant on the alternate list.
