Trustees Scholarship Guidelines

Complete the following by the priority deadline of **March 31, 2010** to receive full funding (Trustees Scholarship applications will be accepted on a first-come basis – should funding remain – until October 1, 2010).

- Complete the Belmont Technical College Application for Admission (available online at www.btc.edu).
- File your *2010-2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov.
BTC school code is 009941.
- Submit this **2010 Trustees Scholarship Application** to BTC Financial Aid Office.

Eligible candidates must also meet the following requirements:

- Graduate from high school and forward official and final transcripts to the Records Office at BTC.
- Reside in Belmont, Harrison or Monroe counties.
- Enroll at BTC in the summer or fall quarter immediately following your high school graduation.
- Enroll in *Student Learning and Success* (PSY104).
- Attend the **Trustees Scholarship Recognition Banquet** on August 24, 2010.

Please make early arrangements to attend this banquet.

Important Information

- The Trustees Scholarship will cover your **tuition** expenses only. Students who receive grants, such as the Federal Pell Grant will have the grants applied to tuition expenses first. If grant money exceeds the cost of tuition, your Trustee Scholarship amount will be zero (\$0.00) and the remaining grant funds can be used to help pay for fees and books. If your total grant money is less than the cost of tuition, the Trustees Scholarship will cover the remaining amount of tuition.
- After your grant money and Trustee Scholarship benefits are applied to your account, you may still owe for fees and books. Students may use other scholarship money and/or student loans to pay for fees, books, supplies, and other approved college-related expenses.
- The Trustees Scholarship recipients are selected by the Financial Aid Office based on eligibility, funding and meeting Trustees Scholarship deadlines.
- The Trustees Scholarship is available for nine consecutive quarters and students must enroll in the summer or fall quarter immediately following their high school graduation.
- Trustees Scholars must maintain a quarterly GPA of 2.5 and must be enrolled full time (12 credits or more per quarter is considered full time).
