BTC JOINS WHATCOM ALLIANCE FOR HEALTH ADVANCEMENT FOR INSURANCE SIGNUP EVENT DEC. 2

What: Need help choosing and signing up for a health insurance plan? You don't have to go through the process alone. Bellingham Technical College has partnered with Whatcom Alliance for Health Advancement (WAHA) to host an open-enrollment sign-up event for health insurance on Wednesday, Dec. 2, in Campus Center, Room 239 from 11:30-2:30 pm. This event is free and open to students and members of the community. Community members attending this event can park in the Visitor Lot (entrance off of Nome Street) and sign in on the sheets provided in the College Services building.

Attendees will need to bring:

- Names, dates of birth, & Social Security numbers for all members of your household;
- Proof of income; and
- Immigration documents (if applicable)

Open Enrollment for 2016 coverage runs from November 1, 2015, through January 31, 2016. Eight out of 10 people who enrolled in health coverage through Washington Healthplanfinder qualified for financial help to make their monthly premiums more affordable. Those who choose not to buy health insurance this year may need to pay a fine on their taxes.
