SPRING APPOINTMENTS AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC AT BTC DENTAL CLINIC

Bellingham — Students and community members interested in receiving dental care at a reduced price can schedule an appointment at Bellingham Technical College's Dental Clinic this spring.

BTC's Dental Clinic is currently looking for patients in need of routine dental care: exams, x-rays, cleanings, and simple fillings. Appointment times vary depending on the program and session, but the clinic is generally open Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. There are a limited number of Saturday appointments available this spring for those patients needing simple fillings.

The Dental programs at BTC provide affordable dental care at our on-campus dental clinic from October to June, with some summer sessions. The clinic prepares students for their careers in dentistry, providing the opportunity to care for a variety of patients and incorporate classroom learning into real-life, practical applications. Community members benefit by receiving high-quality care at reduced fees. Work is performed by both licensed professionals and students. Dental services provided by students are closely supervised by licensed staff and faculty.



Before accepting a new patient, we will schedule a diagnostic appointment to determine whether the person qualifies for our student requirements. For more about how our process works, see our attached Dental Patient Policy.

Fees are typically about 30-50 percent lower than private dental clinics depending on the procedure and how involved students are in performing the service. Patients are charged on a pay-as-you-go basis. The clinic accepts cash, checks, debit and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard), but does not bill insurance companies for patients. Typical appointment lengths are longer than in private dental clinics.

The clinic is located in Building C on BTC's campus. Free parking is available next to the clinic, though visitors are required to sign in for parking in the C Building lobby.
