Please Note:

3. Driving records can be obtained for a fee. It is the responsibility of the applicant to pay for and order his/her driving records. You may obtain a copy of your current, complete driving record at your local Department of Licensing or by accessing the Washington State Department of Licensing on the web at www.dol.wa.gov.

Admissions Requirements & Industry Expectations: Automotive & Diesel Technology Programs

Because program students are required to drive vehicles while enrolled in the Automotive & Diesel programs, applicants are required to present a valid, current driver's license (with no restrictions due to driving offenses attached) and a current, complete 3-year Driving Record. Students are required to maintain a valid driver's license throughout the program.

Please note that it is possible for a student to be admitted to and successfully complete the program and still be denied the following:

Program Internship opportunities: All students must complete internship experiences in the Automotive and Diesel programs. Employers may only allow students with clean driving records to begin or complete an internship.

Future employment opportunities: Completion of the Automotive or Diesel program does not guarantee employability. Hiring facilities may take driving record issues into consideration when choosing new employees and may conduct pre-employment driving record checks.

If you are unsure if your driving record will prevent you from obtaining an internship or future employment and would like to discuss specific infractions, please contact C-Anne Savage at C-Anne.Savage@btc.edu and she will set up an appointment.
