Bellingham, Washington – February 1, 2019 – Come and visit Bellingham Technical College's fully operational dental clinic for teeth cleanings, exams, x-rays, fillings, crowns, root canals, extractions and more. BTC offers a wide range of dental services at approximately 1/3 less than the cost with BTC students and veterans receiving approximately 50% off of most procedures.
