STANDARDS AND EXPECTATIONS

The primary objective of Bellingham Technical College is to prepare an educated workforce. In training students, Bellingham Technical College stresses equally the development of technical skills, communication and interpersonal skills, and positive work habits and attitudes that are required for employment. As a result, Bellingham Technical College expects the following:

Progress

Each student will demonstrate satisfactory progress toward meeting program objectives. Satisfactory progress is defined as maintaining a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average and completing a minimum of 66% of the coursework each quarter. Individual degree/certificate programs may require higher level academic standards in defining satisfactory progress. These requirements will be made available to students upon enrollment. Degree/Certificate program students must attain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 for the total program in order to be eligible for a program completion degree/certificate.

Attendance

Bellingham Technical College requires regular attendance. This standard will be reflected in the grading policy within each degree/certificate program. The College believes attendance is a critical workplace competency and is important overall to student success.

Campus Code of Conduct

All students are subjected to the Bellingham Technical College Campus Code of Conduct published in Chapter 495B-120 of the Washington Administrative Code and as defined in the Bellingham Technical College Student Handbook. Disciplinary action may be taken for a violation of any provision of the student code, for violation of other College rules, or for other types of misconduct defined in the Campus Code of Conduct. Enrollment in the College carries with it the requirement that the student will conduct oneself as a responsible member of the community. This includes an expectation that the student will obey appropriate laws, will comply with the rules of the College and its departments, and will maintain a high standard of integrity and honesty. Sanctions for violations of College rules or conduct that interferes with the operation of college affairs will be dealt with by the College, and the College may impose sanctions independently of any action taken by civil or criminal authorities. In the case of minors, misconduct may be referred to parent or legal guardians.
