- Work Study employees may not exceed the wages and hours referenced in the referral.

I. EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS TO BE DERIVED BY STUDENTS IN THIS JOB:

Students who serve as a TRIO tutors will gain experience with tutoring/teaching and better understand how to support students' academic growth.

TRIO tutors will be part of a team comprised of TRIO staff and other Work Study employees/students. They will gain transferable skills related to teamwork, technology use, communication, and interpersonal skills.

II. SUMMARY OF JOB:

Provide 1:1 or small group tutoring for TRIO students who are taking Biology and/or Math classes. Tutoring sessions may be scheduled in-person or online (Zoom). Ideally, the tutor would be comfortable with both biology and math content but not required.

Support students with completing BIO and/or Math homework assignments, studying for tests, reviewing vocabulary, discussing key concepts, etc. Assist students in utilizing active learning strategies and accessing educational resources to support their progress.

III. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Available for 10-15 hrs per week. Note: may require occasional evenings
- 2. Two quarters of college with a minimum grade of "B" or better in courses in which student will be tutoring.
- 3. Good interpersonal skills and ability to think creatively about problems
- 4. Reliable, compassionate, growth mindset about learning

IV. AVAILABILITY REQUIREMENTS OR EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. Available for 10-15 hrs per week. Note: may require occasional evenings
- 2. Shifts may be in-person or on Zoom depending on needs of the students being tutored
- 3. Consistent and punctual
- 4. This position does not work during academic breaks.
