All Student members will be/have:

- 1. Good intentions and an understanding of the S&A Fee Committee's mission prior to committing to become a member. Additionally, members will conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner.
- 2. An S&A Fee paying student.
- 3. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 4. Not be on academic or disciplinary probation within the school or program.
- 5. The intent of serving for one (1) academic year or until degree completion, whichever comes first.

In the event a student voting member is habitually absent from meetings, fails to respond to attempts to contact, or is deemed unable to participate in the committee due to the guidelines above, that person can be removed from membership by a super-majority vote which is defined as a minimum of seven (7) voting members of the S&A Fee Committee.
