1. CLEP Testing

Students who have taken College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams may receive credit. By obtaining a particular score, recommended by the American Council of Education, students can obtain college credit. Students must submit official CLEP scores and a completed Evaluation Request form to the Admissions Office. Credit awarded will be indicated in the student database and will appear on the graduate's record of cumulative waiver/transfer earned upon program completion.
