

Connecting to the BTC Wireless Network

You can use the BTC wireless network to connect to the internet using your notebook computer or similar wireless device.

Network Settings for Windows XP/Vista/7

- **Windows XP:**

- Right-click on the "Wireless Network Connection:" icon
- Select "View Available Wireless Networks".
- Select the "BTC Hotspot".
- Click "Connect".



- **Windows Vista/7:**

- Right Click on the "Wireless Network Connection:" icon.
- Select the "BTC Hotspot".
- Click "Connect."



Macintosh Network Settings (OS X):

- Select Apple Menu, then System Preference, then Network button.
- Select TCP/IP tab and configure "Using DHCP."
- Above the TCP/IP tab, you may need to configure via "AirPort" or other wireless (WiFi) Ethernet.
- Leave Domain Name Servers and Search Domains blank.

Once connected, the "Wireless Network Connection:" icon should change to  (XP) or  (Vista/7)

Open your web browser (i.e. Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc). You will be automatically directed to the BTC homepage.

If you leave the BTC homepage, you will be prompted to enter a username and password. This is **NOT** your personal BTC username and password. Please consult your instructor or a library staff member for the current username and password. **NOTE:** Login information may change on a quarterly basis.

After you have logged in you will be presented with a popup window. Do **NOT** close this window! Minimize the window and then begin browsing the internet.

When you are ready to disconnect from the wireless network, maximize the login window and click the "Logout" button.
