Annual Program Ready List-Nursing

The Annual Program Ready List-Nursing is a blended process of first-come, first-served and ranking by points for qualified Nursing Program applicants that is valid for one academic year. The Program Ready List will only accept applications during the core program admissions application window. The application window for this program opens in January and will remain open through the summer. Complete applications will be added to the Program-Ready Waitlist in the date/time order in which they are received and based on the point system. On the first day of the spring quarter, the waitlist will be cleared and the applicants not selected for that academic year will need to reapply once the next academic year's Application Window opens.

How to Apply

1. All applicants to the BTC Nursing Program must be **Program-Ready** before they can apply online during the Application Window. Students are Program-Ready once they have completed the following steps:
 - Current BTC application on file with Associate in Nursing as the program of intent.
 - Complete all prerequisite foundational courses with required minimum grades and number of credits. **Transcript evaluation process for all transfer courses must be complete and in your BTC student record. Please note that it takes 6-8 weeks to process transcripts once they arrive at BTC.**
 - Students are encouraged to conduct a self-audit before submitting their application to their intended program. These [Self-Audit Instructions](#) serve as a guide to ensure they meet all requirements and are fully prepared to apply.
 - **Approved** Nursing Healthcare Experience Verification form. Applicants must submit the completed Nursing Healthcare Experience Verification Form and accompanying documentation for program review and approval.

Points system

- Each complete application earns 1 point for each of the following criteria:
- Successful completion (minimum grade met) of 15 or more credits of nursing prerequisite courses at BTC (does not include program/certificate credits; repeated courses only count once)
- Successful completion (minimum grade met) of 30 or more credits of nursing prerequisite courses at BTC (does not include program/certificate credits; repeated courses only count once)
- Successful completion of an Allied Health degree or certificate program at BTC
- Applied last academic year with a complete application
- Applied the last 2 consecutive years with a complete application

Awarding Cohort Seats

- Only Program-Ready students with complete applications will be placed on the Annual Program Ready List.
- The Annual Program Ready List will be sorted first-come-first-served and the highest number of points with the earliest date/time stamp.
- Applicants who are not awarded seats will need to reapply during the next Application Window.
- If an applicant declines a seat in a cohort that seat will then be offered to the first applicant on the alternate list.
