- Introduction of Statistics (MATH& 146) 5 credits
- Lifespan Psychology (PSYC& 200) 5 credits **(Not Required for Practical Nursing)**
- Human A & P 1 (BIOL& 241) 5 credits
- Human A & P 2 (BIOL& 242) 5 credits
- Introduction to Chemistry (CHEM& 121) OR General Chemistry w/ Lab I (CHEM& 161) 5 credits
- Microbiology (BIOL& 260) 5 credits **(Not Required for Practical Nursing)**

Completion of the following courses with a minimum grade of 2.0 (C) or higher in each course:

- General Biology with Lab (BIOL& 160) 5 credits
- General Psychology (PSYC& 100) 5 credits

- Humanities Electives 10 credits - may combine multiple courses **(Not Required for Practical Nursing)**
- Communication Electives 5 credits - may combine multiple courses (CMST& 210 not accepted) **(Not Required for Practical Nursing)**

Additional requirements for entry:

- Approved Healthcare Experience Verification form on file with BTC
- ATI TEAS: score at the "PROFICIENT" level or higher in each of the four areas on one transcript
